

# MRS. ISAAC SELIGMAN, 91

Widow of Investment Banker,  
Mother of Financier, Dies

Mrs. Guta Loeb Seligman, widow of Isaac Newton Seligman, head of J. & W. Seligman, investment bankers, died yesterday in Beacon, N. Y., after a long illness. Her age was 91.

Mrs. Seligman, who formerly lived at 1107 Fifth Avenue, was the daughter of Solomon Loeb, a founder of Kuhn, Loeb & Co., and Mrs. Betty Gallenberg Loeb. She had been active in the Blythedale Home for Convalescent Children and the Solomon and Betty Loeb Convalescent Home, both in Westchester County.

The Seligmans had two children, Joseph L. Seligman, financier, who died in 1944, and Mrs. Margaret Seligman Lewisohn, widow of Samuel Lewisohn. Mrs. Lewisohn died in 1954.

Mrs. Seligman leaves five grandchildren and thirteen great-grandchildren.
